American Democracy

LINDA AND PETE CLAUSSEN



In support of the summer 2017 opening of *American Democracy: A Great Leap of Faith* at the National Museum of American History, a combined \$6 million gift and bequest intention by Linda and Pete Claussen endows and supports the exhibition's opening and continuing programming. The Linda and Pete Claussen Hall of American Democracy will host the exhibition, which explores the nation's commitment to popular sovereignty and the ideals and ideas of a democracy. Pete Claussen is a past chairman of the museum's board and has served on the Smithsonian National Board and National Portrait Gallery Commission. Committed friends of the Smithsonian since 1997, the Claussens also donated the 44-seat segregation-era Southern Railway car now on exhibit in the National Museum of African American History and Culture.

Changing the Game

MICHAEL JORDAN AND FAMILY



In Germany in 1936, African American sprinter Jesse Owens shattered barriers and perceptions by demonstrating that race was no impediment to his ability to compete and win in the Olympics. Generations of African American athletes who followed him used sports to overcome racial obstacles and gain participation in American society. A \$5 million gift by Michael Jordan and Family to the National Museum of African American History and Culture celebrates the many African American athletes whose actions both on and off the field transformed sports, the nation and the world. The museum's Game Changers Hall of the Sports Gallery, named in honor of his generosity, features the personal objects and stories of those who have used the power of sports to advance civil rights, including one of Michael Jordan's own jerseys from the 1996 National Basketball Association Finals.

Nation of Faiths

LILLY ENDOWMENT INC.



Faith and religion have long been intertwined in American history, influencing virtually every facet of society and culture. Within the African American community, religion has been a pillar of daily life. To advance research, educational programming and preservation of artifacts related to faith as experienced through an African American lens, a gift of \$10 million by Lilly Endowment Inc. supports the creation and endowment of the Center for the Study of African American Religion at the Smithsonian's newest museum. A separate gift of \$5 million from Lilly Endowment Inc. endows a curatorship of American religious history at the National Museum of American History. Each of these gifts enables the Smithsonian not only to better tell the personal stories of spiritual practice and interpret American religious freedom throughout history, but also to partner with faith communities across the country to preserve local histories and cultures. Lilly Endowment Inc. has supported the Smithsonian since 1973.

Philanthropic Leader

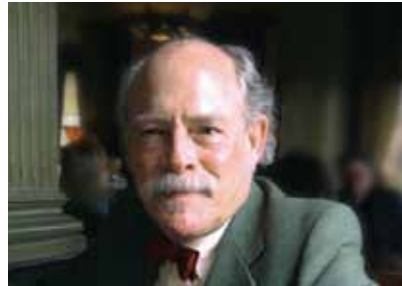
DAVID M. RUBENSTEIN



David M. Rubenstein's gift of \$10 million to the National Museum of African American History and Culture helped build and open the museum building. The National Mall facility is a place for reflection upon four centuries of the nation's history and a catalyst for discussion of the impact of the African American experience on every aspect of the American character. The three History Galleries are named in honor of David Rubenstein in recognition of this generous gift, and in them will be displayed two rare documents on loan from him: the 13th Amendment and the Emancipation Proclamation, the latter signed by President Abraham Lincoln. As well as chairing the Smithsonian Board of Regents, David Rubenstein co-chairs the Smithsonian Campaign, serves on the board of the National Museum of Natural History and is a former board member of the National Museum of American History. His generosity has extended across the Smithsonian to the National Zoological Park, Smithsonian American Art Museum, National Museum of Natural History and National Museum of American History.

Folk Sounds

SAGE FOUNDATION



Like the blend of America's diverse cultural backgrounds, America's folk music cannot be characterized by a simple description. From blues and jazz, to country, gospel, zydeco and more, Chris Strachwitz of Arhoolie Records traveled America's back roads for more than 50 years to capture and collect as many of its folk sounds he enjoyed as possible. A \$5 million gift by Edmund and Laura Littlefield of the Sage Foundation made it possible for the Smithsonian Center for Folklife and Cultural Heritage to receive Arhoolie Records' master recordings and related materials and add them to the collection. Through the center's Smithsonian Folkways label, Arhoolie's rich and uniquely American musical legacy of hundreds of seminal folk artists, among them Big Mama Thornton, Mance Lipscomb and Flaco Jiménez, will continue to be available to listeners around the world. Connection, Ownership, Pride

ROBERT FREDERICK SMITH



A \$20 million gift from Robert Frederick Smith to the National Museum of African American History and Culture provides \$5 million to build the new museum facility and a further \$15 million to advance the museum's digitization, community outreach and internship and fellowship programs. These three programs will expand the museum's ability to share African American history and culture with audiences across the nation and around the world. The Digitization Program will enable the museum to acquire, preserve and digitize collections of a wide array of African American artists and organizations. The gift provides funding to license these works for educational purposes and build a sophisticated digital platform to make them freely accessible. Through the Community Outreach Program, the museum will enhance its partnerships with community-based organizations in key cities across the nation. The gift funds the development of the digital tools or "apps" that will enable those communities to digitize and upload images and documents and share them with others. By allowing individuals and families to contribute and curate their own stories, pictures and more, the museum can weave the story of all African American families into a narrative about the African American

experience. The intent of the donor is to create the connection, ownership and pride in the history of all African American families. The Internship and Fellowship Program provides resources to offer professional development opportunities for the next generation of museum professionals with an interest in African American history and culture. In recognition of Robert Smith's generosity, the museum's second-floor Explore Your Family History Center and first-floor family pavilion are named in his honor. The gift is the largest single gift the museum has received.

Committed Since the Beginning

THE OPRAH WINFREY CHARITABLE FOUNDATION



In October 2004, the Smithsonian Board of Regents appointed Oprah Winfrey a founding member of the National Museum of African American History and Culture Council. In the dozen years since, leading up to the museum building's opening on the National Mall on Sept. 24, 2016, she has been a dedicated volunteer and philanthropic leader whose involvement has been critical to this historic project and the realization of this long-awaited dream. With philanthropic contributions from The Oprah Winfrey Charitable Foundation, Oprah Winfrey helped establish the museum's nucleus fund in 2008, made a gift of \$12 million in 2013 and presented an additional gift of \$8 million in 2016. In total, her support to the museum through her foundation is \$21 million, which makes Oprah Winfrey the museum's largest donor. In addition, she has helped build the museum's collection by contributing objects from her personal collection. With her deep commitment, she has played a vital role in bringing the museum's narrative of the African American experience to the nation and the world, so that a more complete American story now may be shared with all.

Leadership Gifts

AARP

 With a \$1 million gift to the National Museum of African

American History and Culture, AARP supports the museum's mission to explore African American life through economic, social, political and cultural experiences. By exploring stories from the nation's founding to contemporary times, the Smithsonian's newest museum encourages visitors to think about how they can make America a more just and equitable place through discussions of race and social justice. In its history of giving to 11 Smithsonian museums, research centers and programs since 1983, this is AARP's largest donation to date.

BANK OF AMERICA



A gift of \$2 million from Bank of America supported Grand Opening Activities at the Smithsonian's National Museum of African American History and Culture on Sept. 24, 2016. Over 100,000 attendees participated in the dedication ceremony, which featured remarks by President Barack Obama, Rep. John Lewis, former President George W. Bush and the museum's founding director, Lonnie Bunch. The museum chronicles the role African Americans have had in shaping America through 85,000 square feet of exhibition space and thousands of objects. Bank of America has previously made gifts to this museum and 14 other Smithsonian museums, research centers and programs.

BROWN CAPITAL MANAGEMENT



A gift of \$1 million from Brown Capital Management helped the Smithsonian achieve its most recent major milestone, the completion of the National Museum of African American History and Culture on the National Mall. After more than 100 years as a concept, and in the planning and construction phases for more than a decade, the museum's grand opening weekend in September 2016 made national headlines and drew thousands of visitors to participate in its dedication. This is Brown Capital Management's first gift to the Smithsonian.

KOBE AND VANESSA BRYANT FAMILY FOUNDATION

A \$1 million gift from the Kobe and Vanessa Bryant Family Foundation to the National Museum of African American History and Culture helped fuel the completion of the Smithsonian's 19th museum. With over 36,000 objects and myriad stories that serve as a testament to African Americans' contributions to the nation's identity, the museum is a place that helps all Americans learn how their personal stories, histories and cultures are also shaped by global influences.

SANDRA J. EVERS-MANLY



Sandra J. Evers-Manly's gift of \$1 million supports the historic completion and opening of the new facility for the National Museum of African American History and Culture. Encompassing more than 400,000 square feet with thousands of objects, sculpture, memorabilia and photographs, including a deep collection of images documenting African

Americans' struggles during the 1960s Civil Rights Movement, the museum explores the diversity of the African American experience and demonstrates how this experience has been integral to change in America.

THE EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP COUNCIL, INC.



With its gift of \$1 million to the National Museum of African American History and Culture, The Executive Leadership Council, Inc., has enabled the Smithsonian to complete the three-tiered facility that so magnificently houses this new museum. More than 700,000 passes were distributed for timed-entry slots to the museum in its first three months, drawing diverse audiences from across the nation and around the world eager to explore the narratives of African American history presented by the museum's inaugural exhibitions. The council has previously supported the National Museum of African Art.

EXELON FOUNDATION



A \$1 million gift from the Exelon Foundation helps the newly opened National Museum of African American History and Culture share stories from African American history, culture and community for a richer understanding of history writ large. The museum's 12 inaugural exhibitions feature more than 3,000 artifacts that span the 17th century through the current day. They vividly help create awareness of this nation's civic and social diversity and portray how African American values have shaped present-day America.

ROGER W. FERGUSON, JR. AND ANNETTE L. NAZARETH

A \$1 million gift by Roger W. Ferguson, Jr. and Annette L. Nazareth provided critical private support for the completion and grand opening of the National Museum of African American History and Culture in September 2016. Visitors to the Smithsonian's 19th museum can explore images, objects and interactive exhibits as well as participate in discussions, performances and film screenings, to understand the broader American experience through an African American lens. Roger Ferguson is a Smithsonian Regent.

JULIE AND GREG FLYNN



Julie and Greg Flynn have made a \$1 million gift to the National Museum of American History. Their generosity will

support American Experiments, educational programming that inspires active engagement in American civic life. It will be presented in the museum's Wallace H. Coulter Unity Square beginning in summer 2017. The museum will expand these activities to classrooms for use by teachers, in collaboration with San Francisco's Exploratorium. Julie Flynn serves on the Smithsonian National Board and the Smithsonian Campaign's San Francisco regional Host Committee. The Flynn's have supported the Smithsonian since 2014.

THE SIDNEY E. FRANK FOUNDATION

PETER AND CATHY HALSTEAD

The Sidney E. Frank Foundation's gift of \$2 million helps the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden create unique opportunities for visitors to engage with the art of today by reimagining the museum's public spaces and programs. The funds support museum initiatives such as a redesign of its lobby and

outdoor areas, the presentation of several groundbreaking exhibitions, the ongoing work of the ARTLAB+ afterschool program for teens, the creation of a mobile museum guide and other programming.

ANDRÉA AND KENNETH FRAZIER

When it opened on the National Mall in September 2016, the National Museum of African American History and Culture was a long-awaited dream come true. A \$1 million gift by Andréa and Kenneth Frazier helped realize that vision. The new facility's exhibitions and programming are dedicated to enabling people from all walks of life, all over the world, to understand how American values and daily life have been influenced by African American experiences and contributions. The couple has supported the Smithsonian through gifts to this museum, as well as the National Museum of African Art, since 2010.

PATRICIA AND PHILLIP FROST



To enable the Smithsonian to tell a more complete story of America, a \$1 million gift by Patricia and Phillip

Frost helped the Smithsonian complete the construction of the National Museum of African American History and Culture. The new museum offers deep insights into the African American experience through explorations of resilience, diversity, collaboration and cooperation. Patricia Frost is a past chair of the Smithsonian National Board and Phillip Frost is a Smithsonian Regent Emeritus. The Frosts have supported the Smithsonian for almost 30 years and previously have made gifts benefiting the Smithsonian American Art Museum and Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum.

SUSAN BREAKEFIELD FULTON



A \$1 million gift by Susan Breakefield Fulton to establish the Breakefield Critical Conservation Fund supports the

work of the Smithsonian Conservation Biology Institute as it advances vital research to understand and sustain threatened species and their habitats worldwide. At facilities in Front Royal, Va., and the National Zoological Park, as well as at research stations and in the field worldwide, institute researchers and scientists apply the study of ecology, genomics, sustainability, behavior and reproduction to help endangered species including the black-footed ferret and scimitar-horned oryx, both of which have been successfully reintroduced to the wild with institute help. This is the largest gift to the Smithsonian to date from the donor, a member since 2002.

DAVID GEFFEN FOUNDATION



With its support of the design and construction of the National Museum of African American

History and Culture, the \$1 million gift by the David Geffen Foundation helped the Smithsonian successfully launch its newest museum in Washington, D.C., in the fall of 2016. The museum's collections, exhibitions and public programs serve as catalysts for public discourse on the African American experience and the impact this experience has had on America's ever-changing national identity. This is the largest gift to the Smithsonian by the foundation, whose past support has included gifts to the Archives of American Art and the Smithsonian American Art Museum.

JAMES T. AND JULIETTE J. GEORGE



The Smithsonian's newest museum, the National Museum of African American

History and Culture, invites visitors to examine their own cultural and historical influences by enabling conversations on diversity. A \$1 million gift from James T. and Juliette J. George advances the museum's mission of broadening perspectives by telling stories of strength, sacrifice and aspiration from a perspective that is uniquely African American, yet informs the experiences of every American. The couple have been donors to the museum's capital campaign since 2014.

JOSEPH L. AND EMILY K. GIDWITZ MEMORIAL FOUNDATION

A \$1 million gift by the Joseph L. and Emily K. Gidwitz Memorial Foundation establishes an endowment for the acquisition of portrait photography at the National Portrait Gallery. Photography comprises more than half the exhibitions on public view and a majority of the portraits acquired over the last several years. The gift is one of the largest in the museum's history and the first to establish an endowment dedicated to the expansion of its collections. This gift, the donor's first to the Portrait Gallery, ensures the museum can continue to portray the people who shape America's evolving cultural identity in crisp detail.

GLAXOSMITHKLINE



A \$2 million gift by GlaxoSmithKline helped the Smithsonian realize the long-awaited dream of the design,

construction and opening of its newest museum, the National Museum of African American History and Culture. The African American story is one of perseverance, fortitude and immense achievement, celebrated in this new museum through more than 3,000 objects from history, music, sports, art, performing arts and the military on display alongside changing exhibitions and educational programs. Among GlaxoSmithKline's founders were leaders in the abolitionist movement, including William Allen, a passionate campaigner against slavery.

MARY LIVINGSTON GRIGGS AND MARY GRIGGS BURKE FOUNDATION

A \$2 million pledge by the Mary Livingston Griggs and Mary Griggs Burke Foundation establishes an endowment to support the Japanese art program at the Freer | Sackler. The endowment, named in honor of the late Mary Griggs Burke, will enhance the museum's Japanese art exhibitions, research and programming, as well as its Japanese art conservation. With over 11,000 objects spanning more than four millennia, the galleries' Japanese art collection is a central part of a dynamic crossroads of art where East meets West.

WILLIAM H. GROSS



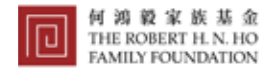
With his gift of \$1 million to the National Postal Museum, William H. Gross continues his deep

commitment to the conservation, preservation and education of the public about the value and beauty of postage stamps. This most recent gift establishes an endowment to support the museum's stamp gallery, which is named in the donor's honor, and which with 200,000 objects on display is the largest gallery in the world dedicated to philately. The museum intends to build on the endowment with additional gifts. William H. Gross has given more than \$10 million to the museum since 2009, including the lead gift that helped make possible the creation of its stamp gallery.

LYDA HILL

A gift by Lyda Hill of \$1.15 million energizes the National Museum of Natural History's transformation of its iconic dinosaur and fossil hall, which reopens in 2019. The funds support fabrication and construction of *Deep Time*, a 31,000-square-foot exhibition that explores how ancient forces have shaped all life on Earth and promotes understanding of our place in Earth's history. The gift also supports a scientist working in geologic research and *Outbreak*, an upcoming exhibition about the interconnectedness of human, animal and environmental health. This is Lyda Hill's largest gift to the natural history museum.

THE ROBERT H.N. HO FAMILY FOUNDATION



A gift by The Robert H.N. Ho Family Foundation enables the Freer | Sackler to open *Encountering the Buddha: Art and Practice Across Asia* in October 2017. The exhibition offers "encounters" through art; immersive spaces, including a recreation of a Tibetan Buddhist shrine with over 200 sculptures, thangkas and ritual objects; and a film of present-day worshippers at a sacred site in Sri Lanka. The centrality of pilgrimage within Buddhist tradition is conveyed by a digital interactive on Hyecho, the Korean monk who traveled across the Buddhist world in the 8th century. The foundation has supported the Freer | Sackler since 2010.

CATHY HUGHES AND ALFRED C. LIGGINS III



By making their \$1 million gift to the design and construction of the National Museum of African American

History and Culture, Cathy Hughes and her son, Alfred C. Liggins III, helped the Smithsonian realize a dream more than a century in the making. Now in its newly opened building, the museum continues to show the nation and the world how central African American innovation is to the American dream of economic opportunity. Cathy Hughes has been a Charter Member of the museum since 2012.

JOHNSON & JOHNSON



With its gift of \$2 million to the National Museum of African American History and Culture, Johnson & Johnson assisted with the final phases of the design and construction of the Smithsonian's newest museum on the National Mall. This is the largest gift to date from the company, a contributor to 10 different Smithsonian museums and programs since 1991. This gift reflects Johnson & Johnson's commitment to the museum and the role it plays in supporting the communities in which the company's employees live and work and the commitment to leveraging diversity and inclusion to create a better, healthier world.

GREGORY D. AND JENNIFER WALSTON JOHNSON



A \$1 million gift by Gregory D. and Jennifer Walston Johnson benefits the National Air

and Space Museum and the Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute. One half of the gift supports conservation of iconic objects to be included in the first museum's upcoming exhibition *Destination Moon*; the other half of the gift funds two institute research projects, investigating insect neurobiology and the collection of fossil specimens in Central and South America. Jennifer Walston Johnson serves on the Smithsonian National Board. The couple has supported the Smithsonian since 2012, with previous gifts including those made to the National Museum of African American History and Culture and the Smithsonian Campaign.

THE JULIS-RABINOWITZ FAMILY

A \$2 million gift directed by Mitchell R. and Joleen Julis on behalf of the Julis-Rabinowitz Family supports enhancements to the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden's public spaces and establishes the museum's Future Fund. One half of the gift funds improvements to the museum's lobby and sculpture garden and the creation of a welcoming and engaging environment to attract visitors to the museum and encourage them to stay. The other half of the gift expands technological offerings, develops new ways of presenting exhibitions and increases opportunities for visitors to interact in innovative ways with the museum and its art. Joleen Julis is a Hirshhorn trustee. This is the couple's largest gift to the museum.

CARL AND EMILY KNOBLOCH



A \$1.1 million gift from Carl and Emily Knobloch helps the Smithsonian American Art Museum establish a

curatorial endowment named in honor of Elizabeth Broun, who retired in December 2016 after 27 years as the museum's director. The Elizabeth Broun Curatorial Endowment supports all aspects of the museum's curatorial and collections-related work, including but not limited to acquisitions; permanent and temporary curatorial personnel; travel, research, exhibition and installation costs; publications; artists' lectures; and public programs. Two galleries are named for the donors in recognition of their generosity. Carl and Emily Knobloch have supported the museum and been members of the museum's American Art Forum since 2006.

The Kovler Foundation furthered its commitment to the National Museum of African American History and Culture with an additional \$1 million gift to the museum. Emmett Till's story, as well as the hundreds of other individual narratives and thousands of artifacts spanning all of America's history, helps to convey the museum's narrative of the complex, often tragic, African American experience that has shaped the past, present and future of our nation. The foundation has supported the Smithsonian since 1983 and the National Museum of African American History and Culture since 2007.

DALE L. LEFEBVRE



A \$1 million gift by Dale L. Lefebvre supports the design and construction of the National Museum of African

American History and Culture, which was completed in September 2016. Housed within a distinctive new structure on the National Mall, the museum and its scholars use a comprehensive collection of objects to tell the inspiring and challenging stories of faith, hope and resiliency that define the African American experience, from slavery and segregation through today.

LOIDA NICOLAS LEWIS, LESLIE MALAIKA LEWIS AND CHRISTINA LEWIS HALPERN



At first sight of the bronze facade at the National Museum of African American

History and Culture, Loida Nicolas Lewis was inspired to make a second \$1 million gift to the museum, this one on behalf of herself and her daughters, Leslie Malaika Lewis and Christina Lewis Halpern. Her first gift came by way of the Reginald F. Lewis Foundation, founded by her late husband in 1987, of which she is now chair. Mr. Lewis is represented in the museum with a copy of his biography, "Why should white guys have all the fun?", his briefcase and his nameplate.

THE JOHN D. AND CATHERINE T. MACARTHUR FOUNDATION



A \$2 million gift by The John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation assisted with the final push to complete the design and construction of the Smithsonian's newest museum, the National Museum of African American History and Culture. It opened in September 2016, more than a dozen years after its authorization by Congress in 2003 and more than 100 years after the idea for the museum was first conceived. The museum's artifacts, stories and educational programming share how American values such as resiliency, optimism and spirituality are deeply embedded in African American history and culture. The MacArthur Foundation has supported more than a dozen Smithsonian museums, research centers and programs since 1983.

VICTOR AND THADERINE MACFARLANE AND FAMILY



With their \$1 million gift to benefit the National Museum of African American History and Culture, Victor and

Thaderine MacFarlane and their family supported the final stages of design, construction and the public unveiling of the Smithsonian's newest building. Themes of freedom, civil rights and justice are woven throughout the museum's 12 inaugural exhibitions and brought to life through physical artifacts, interactive displays, sculptures and family history research stations, all helping to tell a deeper, richer American story.

ROSE A. MCELRATH-SLADE



A \$1 million gift by Rose A. McElrath-Slade benefits the National Museum of African American History and Culture,

a museum that pays tribute to those who suffered, died, endured slave ships, overcame slavery and marched toward a dream. After a century as a deferred dream and more than a decade in planning and construction, the museum now has come to life, evidence that freedom did ring, is ringing and continues to ring for equality and human rights. Rose A. McElrath-Slade has supported the museum since 2013.

MEDTRONIC FOUNDATION

Medtronic

A \$2 million gift from the Medtronic Foundation provided momentum into the final phase of design and construction of the National Museum of African American History and Culture, which opened with more than 100,000 people in attendance. Its collections

encompass more than 36,000 artifacts, and the museum holds regular film screenings, book readings and discussions to help all Americans learn how their personal histories and stories continue to be shaped by the African American experience.

MICROSOFT CORPORATION



Microsoft Corporation continues its long tradition of support for the Smithsonian with a \$1 million gift to the National Museum of African American History and Culture. Along with helping the Smithsonian complete the construction of the new facility, the funds enable the museum to pursue its mission of enabling visitors from around the nation and the world to learn deeper lessons from the past, explore the present and be inspired for the future. 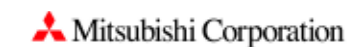
MICHAEL AND LORI MILKEN

Museum of African American History and Culture's mission to demonstrate the ways in which America has been shaped by uniquely African American influences. In addition to thousands of artifacts on display in exhibitions throughout its 10 levels, the museum's robust array of on-site workshops, programming for educators and remote video-conferencing helps learners of all ages discover new insights into the African American experience.

MITSUBISHI CORPORATION



Mitsubishi Corporation's gift of \$1 million supports the Japanese Art Program at the Freer | Sackler over five years. This is Mitsubishi Corporation's largest gift to date to the Smithsonian and supports a variety of the galleries' initiatives: a historic reunion of three large-scale paintings by Japanese artist Kitagawa Utamaro (c. 1753-1806) during the 2017 Cherry Blossom Festival, a bilingual staff coordinator for museum-wide Japanese projects, curatorial and research exchanges between Freer | Sackler staff and Tokyo museums and a Japanese-English website to further museum outreach in Japan. Mitsubishi Corporation has supported the Freer | Sackler and the Smithsonian since 1997.

Because of his efforts and those of many others, the museum is a place where young, old, American and international visitors may explore the African American experience and better understand its impact on the nation and the world.

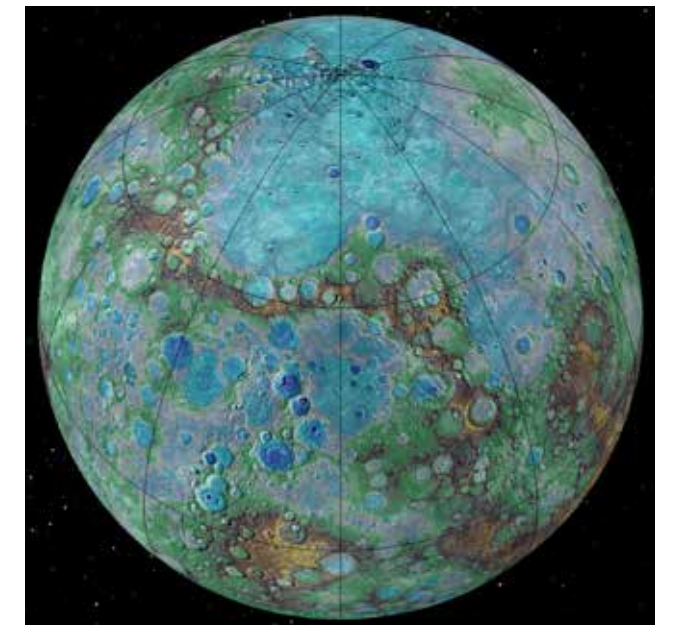

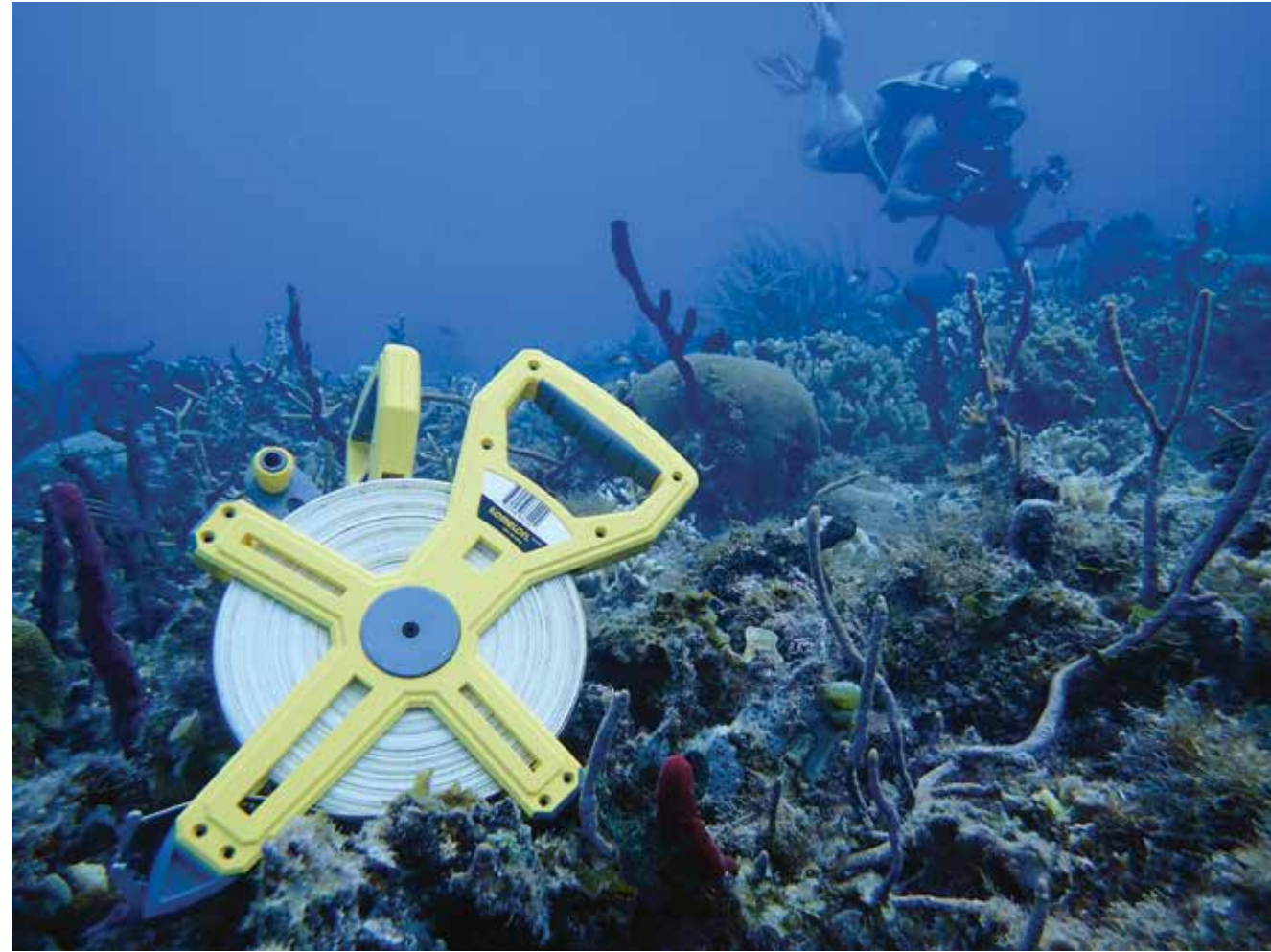
